6	4130 - Aspen	High Density Log	225.0	Uneven Age		OI comments states there is an osprey nest on north end, I never saw a nest. OI says part of stand cut in '70's, looks to have been a highgrade w/ small patches cut here and there. OI says manage for old growth?? I would agree... All in all a very unique stand. Many different age groups of aspen w/in the stand, some younger regen and some older. Balsam regen is thick in some areas. In some areas the aspen is ancient while other areas it is probably in the 60-70 yr. age class..

12	6117 - Lowland Deciduous, Mixed Coniferous	Medium Density	28.9	7		Clearcut from 2002 (a unit cut from the Second Lake Aspen sale). Stand regen is patchy. A couple of older patches of aspen regeneration exists from a highgrade cut 20+ yrs. ago.
13	4110 - Sugar Maple Association	High Density Log	8.9	75	81-110	Very small hardwood. type. It would be nice to thin lightly if we are cutting the adjacent stand. Sugar maple is nice quality. Sugar maple saplings are nice

17	6115 - Lowland Ash	High Density Sapling	17.8	50		Pocket of very low stagnant ground. Black ash is small diameter but is probably really old...
18	6118 - Lowland Deciduous with Cedar	High Density Log	33.1	Uneven Age		Stand of cedar overtopped with large aspen. Stand has a slight slope from East to West and looks like it contains seeps and is wet from the large ridge coming off of adjacent stand.
19	6117 - Lowland Deciduous, Mixed Coniferous	High Density Log	43.8	120		Ancient stand of aspen w/ cedar in the understory. Both species are large in diameter. Small pocket of red maple exists in south part of stand. An occasional large white pine is scattered w/in the stand.
21	4112 - Maple, Beech, Cherry Association	High Density Log	29.8	75	51-80	Stand of nice hardwood thinned roughly 5-7 years ago. Nice sugar maple saplings coming up in within the understory. Also a few beech saplings.. I found a beech in the sale w/ beech bark disease and reported it to Robert Heyd. Also, I noticed many beech within the sale that had top mortality... I could not see scale on these specific trees but am assuming they do have beech bark disease in the crowns.
22	6120 - Lowland Cedar	High Density Log	30.3	118		Stand consists of decent quality cedar. A small stream runs thru the middle of it. Do not manage, the stand provides a good stream buffer and wildlife corridor. An active Goshawk nest exists within the SE corner of stand. It dive bombed me as I walked by... Buffer nest accordingly during timber sale setup. Coordinates are: Lat: 46° 00' 49.57" N Long: 83° 35' 46.10 W

27	4110 - Sugar Maple Association	High Density Log	65.5	70	81-110	Illegal cabin in NE corner of stand. Hardwood is poorer quality and is mixed. The west side of the stand is one long North/South ridge. I noticed a couple of oaks w/in the stand.
28	4111 - S.Maple, Hard Mast Association	High Density Log	28.2	70		Parts of the stand have been marked and is under contract (smurf hardwoods). A few spots on the North side are not w/in the sale because the timber is patchy.
29	6112 - Lowland Aspen	High Density Pole	5.6	70		Small island of aspen with pole sized cedar underneath. Stand is unique in that it is surrounded by a cedar swamp.
30	6112 - Lowland Aspen	High Density Log	185.5	90		Stand contains ancient aspen with a mix of conifer within the understory. Aspen is in poor condition. Access into the stand is very poor.

<b>34</b>	4110 - Sugar Maple Association	High Density Log	55.9	120	81-110	Gothic like looking stand. Hardwood is ancient. Sugar maple regen w/in the understory is decent and is well established. Illegal cabin w/in stand, looks to be last used in '04 according to a camp diary.
