Directions to Site

From M-33, turn west on CR-622 which is approximately 8.5 miles north of Atlanta. Follow 3.9 miles to turn on right (northwest) which is East Branch Road. Continue on East Branch Road 4.0± miles to Blue Lakes Road and then turn left (west). Follow 3.0 miles at which point road turns north. Turn left here and follow trail road to parking sites. River extends southwesterly and may accessed at several points.
