

Boardman River Sabin Dam



Fish Species

Brook Trout; Brown Trout; Steelhead

Species Description

The Boardman River fish community in this location is fairly diverse. Lower numbers of brook trout are found in this reach below Sabin Dam, but large brown trout that move in and out of Boardman Lake frequent this stretch, as well as steelhead, bass, and walleye in the spring time. No stocking occurs in this section of the river and the trout populations are entirely dependent upon natural reproduction.

Noteworthy

This section of the Boardman River is a Type 3 trout stream from the Sabin Dam downstream; above the dam the river is a Type 1 trout stream. The river here is a gravel bottom and very wide; a great spot for beginning casters of all gear types!

Fishing Regulations

This section of the Boardman River is divided with two different fishing regulations. The Boardman River from the Sabin Dam downstream is designated a Type 3 trout stream while above the dam the river is a designated Type 1 trout stream.
