




# KINNEY WATERFOWL PRODUCTION AREA

**Be aware:** Cornish SGA, and adjacent cooperating Federal land, Kinney Waterfowl Production Area (WPA) have: special local rules for parking, limits on the type of boats used on Grass Lake, and shot restrictions (non-toxic). See details below.


**Limit on watercraft types used within Grass Lake:** For both areas, **No Watercraft with Motors** are allowed or may be used, except those with electric motors. Grass Lake is typically shallow, can be very over vegetated, and using a motorized water craft can cause habitat or wildlife damage plus can damage your motor.

**Non-toxic shot restrictions apply:** It is unlawful to use or possess ANY shot, whether loose or loaded in shot shells, of a material other than shot approved as non-toxic by the U.S. Fish & Wildlife Service, except for single projectile loads.

**Waterfowl Production Areas (WPAs)** are Federal lands administrated by the U.S. Fish and Wildlife Service (USFWS) in partnership and cooperation with the Michigan DNR Wildlife Division which manages day-to-day area situations. Hunter Safety Zones of 150 yards (450 feet) are enforced around all buildings/structures at all times.

- [ 1 ] Kinney WPA entrance, off County Road 352: Lat.42°06'46"N, Long.85°49'55"W.
- [ 2 ] Cornish SGA, west-side parking (north of Shaw Road): Lat.42°05'55.3"N, Long.85°50'01.6"W.
- [ 3 ] Cornish SGA, east-side parking (north of Shaw Road): Lat.42°06'08.8"N, Long.85°49'11.6"W.
