




Note: this is a select area of State Forest land, which is managed cooperatively for wildlife by the DNR Wildlife and Forestry Divisions.

- [ 2 ] Houghton Lake N. Flooding parking Lat.44°24'01.7"N, Long.84°47'39.6"W.
- [ 3 ] Dead Stream Flooding parking Lat.44°21'51.1"N, Long.84°51'07.4"W.



**Important!** 150 yards (450 feet) Hunter Safety Zones are enforced around all buildings and structures at all times. Be Safe! Always be careful around water and ditch/dikes for deep water!
