
Location of Area

**WARNING - Important Safety Notice:**

- \* The Manitou Islands are not connected to the mainland of Michigan by roads or regular transportation; access requires a boat or special transport.
- \* Lake Michigan can be extremely hazardous during late fall to spring.
- \* Boating should be carefully considered.
- \* There is NO safe sheltered harbor in which to anchor, yet partial shelter may be found at South Manitou Island
- \* Please plan any trip accordingly



- Land: Sleeping Bear Dunes National Lakeshore (National Park); Federal Land  
*Note there is no State or private land on this island. In the past there has been select special hunting options on this island, but hunts are limited and managed out of the National Parks office. Contact them for details please.*
- Boating: Area has some boating rules; see them off the National Parks website or call them.
- Roads: Trails
- Water: Lakes, Ponds; Rivers, Streams; Seas, Streams, Drains
- Political: Town-Range-Section Lines (labelled 1-36, near center of block)

Not shown on map, but the closest ~shelter harbor for weather emergency, is South Manitou Island (east side) Lat.45°01'22.8"N, Long.85°05'42.1"W.



**Important!: 150 yards or 450 feet Safety Zones (No Shooting!) are enforced around all buildings and structures at all times. Be Safe! Always be careful around water and ditch/dikes for deep water!**

Look for Watchable Wildlife viewing area signs in this area, for locations and more information about trails or features.
