Jerrie Schultz- Compartments 26, 48, 111, 138; Wonderful work keep it up very informative. Thank you

Dale Borske- Nice presentation by your group. I am glad that MI DNR is making the effort to cut and establish new growth for the benefit of wildlife. We really enjoy hunting the Gladwin district. Hoping to try other areas in northern Michigan when more is done. Keep up the good work!

Mark Janeczko- I would like to see more pockets of old growth trees. If an Oak or Beech can survive 200 years let it. These old trees can teach us a thing or two about fighting disease, blights and insects. Please shut down ATV and ORV trails. These machines pollute the landscape with noise, erosion and air pollution. Once a trail is designated they just go off it anyway and destroy something else. Designate foot only nature paths in our woods. Still allow hunting and fishing but keep the engines out. Dump logging debris on closed ATV trails to prevent ATV's and ORV's from having access. Increase fines for dumping on public lands.

Compartment 10 (Stand examiner – Steven Nyhoff)

Changes made at compartment review:

- KW Block 121 is located in this compartment to meet the KW management plan the KW related treatments will have out of year of entry start date. The Start date for timber prep will be 10/1/2021, Trenching in 2025 and Planting in 2026.
- Add a recreation trail protection spec to these KW treatments.

Compartment 20 (Stand examiner – Tim Gallager)

No changes made at compartment review.

Compartment 26 (Stand Examiner – Richard Myrick)

Changes made at compartment review:

- Drop the treatment from stand 1 and place it on stands 56, 58 and 157.
 These treatments will help eliminate a spider web of illegal trails. There will be one trail retained that will be designated as a hunter walking trail in stands 56 and 58. This trail will be a loop that connects to the Gladwin Field Trial area. Work with Wildlife personnel to implement this trail and with an RAS representative to get the trails on the compartment map.
- Add the walking trails in stand 9 to the map.
- Add the railroad grade to the map.
- Add an influence zone site condition to stand 32.

Compartment 48 (Stand examiner – Steven Nyhoff)

No changes made at compartment review.

Compartment 111 (Stand examiner – Scott Shooltz)

Changes made at the compartment review:

 Add a treatment to stands 123 and 214 that coincides with the treatment on stand 241. The addition of these stands will help meet the acreage goals for aspen management within the Midland-Isabella MA.

Compartment 138 (Stand examiner – Richard Myrick)

Changes made at compartment review:

 Add treatments to stands 1, 2, and 102 with a site condition. Pursue access to these stands from the west using new lowland access mats. In addition to the compartments reviewed for the 2018 YOE, there was the review and approval of an ERA plan and SCA-POG removal and reclassification.

Compartment 4 (Stand examiner -Steven Nyhoff)

Rice Pond Pine Barrens ERA Plan- Approved
